

Teeth Crowns Penticton

Crowns or caps are customized dental restorations that are designed to mount overtop of a damaged or broken tooth. Usually, dental crowns will be applied to envelop cracked fillings, chipped, broken, or sensitive teeth and might also be utilized cosmetically to upgrade malformed, malpositioned or discoloured teeth.

Crowns are typically made from durable ceramic materials and are particularly designed to mix organically to your already existing teeth, therefore improving your overall smile. There are times when a crown would be fitting, like when a individual has a large filling that is bigger than the actual remaining tooth. In this case, the framework of the tooth might be too frail to support the big filling. Other reasons you may need a crown is that there is extensive deterioration triggered by tooth corrosion, discoloration, compromised aesthetics, and tooth fractures. Furthermore, after a root canal, teeth can become more frail and more liable to break or fracture. A cap may be used to protect the tooth. In addition, missing teeth can be replaced with a dental bridge, with the adjacent teeth being used as support for the replacement tooth.

Along with delivering the needed stability and protection, crowns can also enrich the cosmetic appeal of your teeth.
