

Penticton Root Canal

Whenever the nerve inside the tooth pulp causes irritations, becomes inflamed, it dies, people must think about root canal procedures. Many of the causes of nerve pulp swelling or death can be due to traumas to the tooth via injuries, the enlargement of cavernous hollows in the tooth, large fixtures, outdated restorations, or long-term grinding of the teeth.

Often times, an infected tooth displays signs and indicators like pain when biting, swelling, sensitivities to hot and cold stimulus, dull aching pain or sharp, shooting pain, and broad pain in the other places of the mouth, neck or head. At times however, there happen to be no discernible signs and symptoms at all. Oral x-rays can be quite a useful tool if the bone tissue around the root of the tooth has undergone resorption because of the infection.

When a tooth dies or becomes contaminated, your options may be either a endodontic treatment to try to salvage the tooth or a full tooth extraction to take out the contaminated tooth and ensuing infection. You should not disregard the pain as it might cause severe infections to the lungs, heart, and brain.
