

## Composite Fillings Penticton

A composite resin white restoration could be utilized for a variety of tooth problems including the mending of fissures, splits and tooth decay. The affected part of the tooth has to be completely removed before the insertion of a synthetic restoration.

There are several different types of dental restorations offered, with each having their own benefits and drawbacks. Composite resin fillings and silver amalgam restorations are the most widely used tooth restorations at the moment. Given that composite resin restorations can directly match the natural colour of your teeth, they are more often used for use on the front teeth where the visible areas of the teeth are.

Clients may require composite fillings to help fix chipped teeth, decayed teeth, worn teeth, broken or cracked teeth, or to close up a gap between teeth.
