

Air Abrasion Dentistry Penticton

The drill free method is recent to oral health care and enables the dental clinician to carry out painless treatments for the most anxious of patients. Drill free has all the benefits that are currently being offered by the standard dentistry drill in a new revolutionary method known as air abrasion.

Performing tasks like taking out hollows or removing decay from teeth can be performed through air abrasion in a far gentler fashion than with a dental drill. This technique makes use of very small abrasive particles being launched by powerful streams of air to help eradicate dental caries from teeth while preventing the decay from spreading any further.

Once the tooth surface is cleared of caries, your oral health care provider might fill the affected area with tooth fillings. The oral health doctor might use a tooth coloured fillings if needed on the front surface of the tooth or put on a dental sealant.
